

LIVINGSTON COUNTY FISCAL COURT  
REQUEST FOR BIDS  
FISCAL YEAR 2026-2027

Notice is hereby given that the Livingston County Fiscal Court will receive sealed bids for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026 and ending June 30, 2027, for the following materials and services:

1. **PROPANE GAS**

For use by the Courthouse, Road Department, Old Ambulance Building, North Ambulance Building, South Ambulance Building, Extension Service (Old Fairgrounds), Livingston County Health Department, Grand Lakes Fire District (all stations), Ledbetter Fire District (all stations), Burna Fire Department, Salem Fire Department, Livingston County Helping Hands, Livingston County Senior Citizens Center, Livingston County Sheriff's Office, and E.O.C. Building. Bidder shall supply tank and quote price per gallon delivered. Vendors may submit either a firm price or cost-plus pricing structure.

2. **DIESEL FUEL AND GASOLINE**

No. 2 Diesel Fuel (High Sulfur and Low Sulfur) and Unleaded Gasoline for the Livingston County Road Department, North Ambulance Service, South Ambulance Service, Ledbetter Water District, and Livingston County Sheriff's Office. Bidder must provide local OPIS Daily Rack Prices for Paducah, Kentucky and furnish copies upon request for verification of pricing.

3. **LIMESTONE**

No. 3 Crushed Limestone, No. 9 Crushed Limestone, 610 Crushed Limestone, No. 67 Limestone, Dense Grade Aggregate, and Rip Rap. All materials shall meet Kentucky Transportation Cabinet specifications. Bids shall include:

- (a) Price per ton delivered F.O.B. Livingston County Road Department, Smithland, Kentucky; and
- (b) Price per ton picked up at the plant.

4. **ASPHALT EMULSIONS**

RS-2 and AE-90 Emulsified Asphalt. Bids shall include:

- (a) Price F.O.B. Livingston County Road Department; and
- (b) Price picked up at terminal.

Materials shall meet the latest Bureau of Highways specifications.

5. **ASPHALT PAVEMENT**

Furnishing and installation of asphalt pavement within Livingston County and the City of Salem, Kentucky. Materials and workmanship shall conform to Section 403 of Kentucky Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction. Contractors must be prequalified by the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet.

6. **TRASH REMOVAL SERVICES**

Waste disposal services for the Livingston County Convenience Center. Bids shall include:

- Disposal rate per ton
- Delivery rate for 30-yard roll-off containers

- Haul rate for loaded roll-off containers
- Haul rate for county-owned compactor containers

Contractor must provide:

- Minimum of two pickups weekly, including Tuesday mornings
- Minimum of five (5) 30-yard roll-off containers
- Seven (7) additional 30-yard roll-off containers twice annually during Spring and Fall Cleanup Events
- Adequate personnel and equipment to service containers during cleanup events

**7. CULVERT MATERIALS**

Polymer-coated pipe, galvanized metal pipe, riveted pipe, arched and round profiles ranging from 12 inches through 96 inches and other related culvert materials. Vendors shall submit:

- Unit pricing
- Quantity discount schedules
- Product specifications
- Shipping methods
- Estimated delivery times

**8. CHIP SEAL MATERIALS**

Chip Seal materials meeting the latest Bureau of Highways specifications. Bids shall include:

- (a) Price F.O.B. Livingston County Road Department; and
- (b) Price picked up at terminal.
